NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on all standard VHF channels. A specific VHF channel for communications from and to the Race Committee will be designated in the sailing instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising is restricted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, Appendix 1, Advertising Code.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 With the approval of the organizing authority, the regatta is open to individuals with a longstanding history with the Shields Class.
- 3.2 Interested skippers should contact the Event Chairmen, John Mawe and Com Crocker (email addresses listed below under 14 FURTHER INFORMATION).
- 3.3 Entries will not be accepted after Saturday, August 9, 2014.

4 BOATS

- 4.1 The regatta shall be sailed in borrowed Shields Class boats.
- 4.2 Boats will be allotted by the organizing authority.

5 FEES

5.1 There is no entry fee for this regatta.

5.2 There will be a casual BBQ on Wednesday evening at a cost of \$25 per person.

6 SCHEDULE

Tuesday, September 9

1700-2000 Registration (in the Pandemonium)

1800 Welcome reception/cocktail party

Wednesday, September 10

800-900 Registration (in the Pandemonium)

1100 First warning signal. The race committee intends to run multiple races.

1400 No warning signal after this time

1800 Awards presentation at the beginning of the Skippers' Meeting for the National Championship Regatta, with casual BBQ to follow

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8 COURSES AND SAILING AREA

8.1 Courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

8.2 The racing area will be in Long Island Sound, south of Larchmont Harbor.

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point Scoring System (Appendix A) will apply with no score excluded.

9.2 One completed race constitutes a series.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, boats shall not have any outside communication while racing that is not available to all boats.

11 MEDIA, SOUND, AND IMAGES

The organizing authority has the right to use any images and sound recorded during the event free of any charge.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for First, Second, and Third Place overall.

13 DISCLAIMER of LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
